Food Truck Load In Instructions

Service Side – Passenger + Food Trailers + Marquees

You will need to enter via Nepean Highway Entrance.

Service Side – Driver

Weights

You will need to have minimum of 10kg but have available 15kg per leg weights. No pegging as venue is crushed concrete.
